Wood (red cedar), pigments

### Description

Pair of carved cedar doors consisting of four parts- the two doors and a carved face for each door that can be removed (by screws); handcarved in a traditional Northwest Coast formline design depicting a bear. Made of red cedar and painted with red and black pigments. Hand carved faces attach to doors (one for each door); colors are natural wood accented with red and black pigment.
