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## Belt Buckle or Pendant

### Date

ca. 1950

### Primary Maker

Los Castillo

### Medium

Metal (Silver, copper, brass, others)

### Description

Round silver belt buckle or pendant with face wearing Pre-Columbian style headdress and earrings of mixed metals (copper, brass, likely alpaca, etc.). Head faces to proper

left. The back has a bent silver rod at proper left for attaching the belt, and a hook at proper right. At top is a loop for attachment to a necklace. Stamped on the back, over the cheek is "Metales Casados."

### Dimensions

Whole:  $\frac{3}{8} \times 2 \frac{1}{16} \times 2 \frac{1}{16}$  in. ( $1 \times 5.2 \times 5.2$  cm)
