



## Woman with Basket of Bread and Fougasse on Her Arm

### Date

Late 1970s - early 1980s

### Primary Maker

Mamie Martin

### Medium

Ceramic, wood, cotton, bread, vegetal fiber (basketry)  
synthetic fiber, paint

### Description

Standing older woman with brown hair under white bonnet has round, pierced flat bread (fougasse) hanging from right arm on string and she holds a dark stained round handled basket on left arm. Basket holds a baguette and a loaf of country bread. Woman wears a long purplish blue gray print skirt and vertically striped long mauve apron. She also wears a deep rose blouse with white camisole. Over her shoulders is a brown, pink, red and purple shawl, pinned in back. Under her skirt is a gray and white striped slip and similar bloomers. Her legs are painted as are her black shoes. On the hardwood stand "Mamie Martin MOF" is signed at right front, "V" at back left.

( $10 \times 7 \times 6.2$  cm) Baguette:  $\frac{3}{4} \times 2 \frac{3}{8} \times \frac{7}{8}$  in. ( $1.9 \times 6.1 \times 2.2$  cm) Country bread:  $\frac{9}{16} \times 1 \frac{1}{2} \times 1 \frac{9}{16}$  in. ( $1.5 \times 3.8 \times 4$  cm)
