### Description

Standing older woman(a) with bundle of firewood wrapped in a black cloth and tied with twine. She has gray hair and is wearing a torn and patched red and black striped skirt,

a black floral print shirt and a black, torn shawl. She has a black kerchief on her head and tan petticoat and pantaloons. Her blue and red socks are painted on, as are her black shoes. Signed "Mamie Martin" and "M. O.F." on top of base. Walking stick(b) made of a twig.
