



Jolly Jiggolette Black Dancing Toy

Description

Instrument comprised of a doll, pole and board. a) doll is wood with square body and articulated arms and legs; round head with black painted top hat and short jacket

and shoes; painted features on face; white painted trousers and shirt front; red felt bowtie; b) board is flat and varnished (?) with paper label on one side printed "Jolly JIGGOLETTE INSTRUCTION SHEET" with printed instructions and manufacturer information; c) metal rod with wood cylinder on end.

Dimensions

Doll: $9 \frac{5}{8} \times 2 \frac{3}{16} \times 2 \frac{5}{16}$ in. (24.5 × 5.5 × 5.8 cm) Board: $\frac{3}{16} \times 24 \times 4$ in. (0.5 × 61 × 10.1 cm) Rod: $12 \frac{5}{8} \times 1 \frac{1}{4} \times 1 \frac{1}{4}$ in. (32 × 3.2 × 3.2 cm)
