A pair of contour edged plates, one with Breton man in checked trouser playing the bombarde (a form of oboe) and the other with a Bretonne woman holding a flower,

both with four part cross-like sectioned borders alternating with gorse (ajonc) sprigs. Signed on back "HB Quimper 222"
