Ceramic; earthenware with tin glaze and copper and manganese in-glaze

### Description

Footed but only visible from the bottom. Exterior plain oyster colored glaze, flared form. Interior has 16 petalled rosette in center surmounted by four rows of brown scallops and green spots. Wheelthrown with ring foot. Ribbing visible on exterior surface.
