Description

Made by Magnus Aase in Bergen Owned by the Didrick Maan Family of Førde parish This bride's crown is made of a gold washed silver cutwork crown with red stones and bowl-shaped dangles. A red wool band attaches to the crown. A cloth flower garland encircles the bottom edge, and 7 brocaded ribbon streamers hang from the garland.
