## Pascola mask

### Medium

Wood, paint, goat hair, glass

### Description

Carved wood mask with white on black paint throughout face, and red on lips. Shorter tufts of goat hair along brow area, and longer tufts along each side of face and chin

area. Cross on forehead, with white triangles along outside edges of face.

### Dimensions

Includes beard and eyebrows. :  $16 \frac{15}{16} \times 5 \frac{1}{2} \times 3 \frac{15}{16}$  in. (43 × 14 × 10 cm) Mask only:  $7 \frac{5}{16} \times 5 \frac{1}{2} \times 3 \frac{15}{16}$  in. (18.5 × 14 × 10 cm)
